

# RIDE *for* 65 ROSES

## Overview

The 2009 Ride for 65 Roses will pass through some of the most scenic towns and terrain this side of the Rockies. Scheduled for Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, the event will feature 20-, 40- & 65-mile routes. Each will provide a beautiful tour of North Boulder and Longmont. Additionally the 40-mile route will offer a gentle climb up Left Hand Canyon to Jamestown while the 65-mile route will provide a tougher climb to the town of Ward. In their March 2007 issue, Bicycling Magazine named the climb to Ward as one of the 100 best climbs in the USA!

## Registration Fee

Through June 19<sup>th</sup>: \$55

June 15<sup>th</sup> – August 28<sup>th</sup>: \$65

Event Day: \$75

## Fundraising

In addition to the registration fee, each participant is asked to raise a minimum of \$125.

## Event Jerseys

Cyclists who raise a minimum of \$200 (not including the registration fee) on or before event day will receive a 2009 commemorative Ride for 65 Roses jersey.

- ~ Each route will have conveniently located SAG stops stocked with refreshments.
- ~ Route marshals and police will be on hand to provide clear directions and safe crossings at key intersections.
- ~ Amateur Radio Operators will provide communication between vital points on the route.
- ~ There will be bike mechanics and SAG vehicles along each route to rescue the weary or broken down cyclists.
- ~ And finally, while we hope we never need them, a medical crew will also be on standby in the event of an emergency.
