*"I get so much fulfillment out of knowing that I am helping prolong someone's life by doing something as simple as collecting change from students at school."*

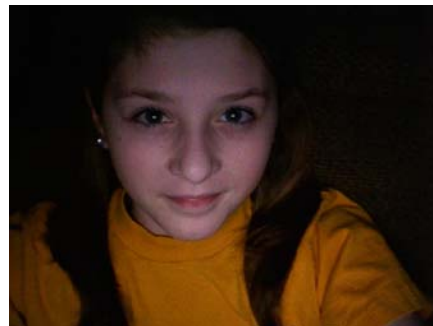
