From the North or South take Route 3 to exit 6 / route 44 East. Head toward Plymouth Center, and drive approximately 1 mile. Right onto Court Street. (route 3A) Follow Court Street through next set of lights -- Court becomes Sandwich Street. Kusmin Art Gallery (1726 white house) is on the corner of North Green and Sandwich Streets at the historic Training Green and next to Howland House Museum. Short walk from waterfront (Rock/Mayflower) and downtown Plymouth.

About Cystic Fibrosis:

Cystic Fibrosis is a genetic disease affecting 30,000 children and adults in the United States. The median age of survival is 37.

The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is a non-profit donor-supported organization. Their focus is to support the development of new drugs to fight the disease, improve the quality of life for those with CF, and to ultimately find a cure.
