Change for a Cure

"Change for a Cure" is a simple fund-raising activity. During the school's fund-raising week, students are asked to collect and turn in spare change each day.

Monday = Collect pennies

Tuesday = Collect nickels

Wednesday = Collect dimes

Thursday = Collect quarters

Friday = Collect dollars

Pin-ups

A pin-up program is a great activity that provides students with the opportunity to support the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.

For a donation of \$1 or more, students can sign their names to a pin-up, or honor a friend by putting the friend's name on the pin-up, and then "pin it up" on "walls of support."

Students may also want to sell pin-ups to family and friends!

Jar Wars

A "Jar Wars" coin drive is easy to implement and provides an opportunity to generate healthy and fun competition among classrooms! It's simple! Students will bring in spare change to support the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.

You can make it fun and build excitement by having each classroom decorate their "jar". Many use large pretzel jugs, big popcorn tins, etc. Have each class present their decorated "jar" at a school assembly and announce their classroom's fund-raising goal. Total all of the classroom goals into the overall school goal. Use the *CureFinders* posters to keep track of your progress. Your principal may want to offer a fun reward if the school exceeds its goal.

Classrooms may want to have students guess how much money is in their jar at the end of each week and present small token awards to the student who is the closest such as letting them lead the group into lunch, special seating in the classroom during an activity, a special ribbon on their chair, etc.
